Men's Varsity Basketball Holds on to District Lead

Behind senior Express-News Player of the Week Jason Brickman's 21 points and senior Sam Perez's 18, the men's varsity basketball team finished off Brandeis 74-57 in front of a large crowd at UTSA. The team then overpowered its nemesis, Stevens High School, by a score of 71-64 to finish the first round of District play with an 8-0 record, 21-5 overall, and a commanding two-game lead over the rest of the field. The win was Clark's first against Stevens since that school's varsity program began three years ago. Brickman again led the Cougars' scoring with 27 points, followed by junior Ansley Benjamin (12 points), Sam Perez (11 points), senior Elhad Emerllahu (10 points), senior Manny Paz y Puente (6 points) and junior Jacob Palacios (5 points). The Cougars' second half of District play began with a win against Marshall, extending their undefeated streak to 9-0. Congratulations to the team and coaches for their excellent play and hard-fought wins.
