### Clark Cougar Girls Varsity Golf

The Clark Cougar Girls Varsity Golf Team began the school year with a shaky start, at the NEISD Texas Shootout at Canyon Springs, October 14-15, coming in 15<sup>th</sup> place, with a two day total of 853. The climb began at the *Holmes' Hunter's Moon at Northern Hills*, October 24 coming in 9<sup>th</sup> place, with a 407.

At the *Brandeis Fall Invitational at Alsatian*, November 29, they placed an impressive 4<sup>th</sup> place with a 390. **Top 4 team totals:** 1<sup>st</sup> Health Careers, 371; 2<sup>nd</sup> Warren, 375; 3<sup>rd</sup> Fredericksburg, 379; 4<sup>th</sup> Clark, 390.

The Woodlands was disappointing, placing 10<sup>th</sup> at the *Vern Edwards Memorial*, January 17-18 with a two day total of 801. The girls obviously knew they needed to refocus. March 20, at the *O'Connor Girls Invitational at Cedar Creek*, the Clark Cougar Girls' team rallied and tied for 2<sup>nd</sup> place, with a 389! **Top 3 team totals:** 1<sup>st</sup> O'Connor, 355; T-2<sup>nd</sup> Health Careers, 389; T-2<sup>nd</sup> Clark, 389.

They ended the *District 27-5A Girls Championship*, April 5-6 placing 5<sup>th</sup>, with a two day total of 772!
